Counting coins is an important skill we work on all year in second grade. We have found real coins are easier for children to work with. This year we are asking for each student to bring in the coins listed below. To help students keep track of their coins all year, we ask that you send the coins in some type of secure case with your child's name on it. For example, a small plastic container, Ziploc baggie or a zipper coin purse are good ways to store the money. There will be a basket within the classroom where the coins will be stored for safe keeping when they are not being used. The coins will be returned at the end of the year.
